The tidy man is a reminder not to litter



It doesn't necessarily mean that this package should be disposed in general waste



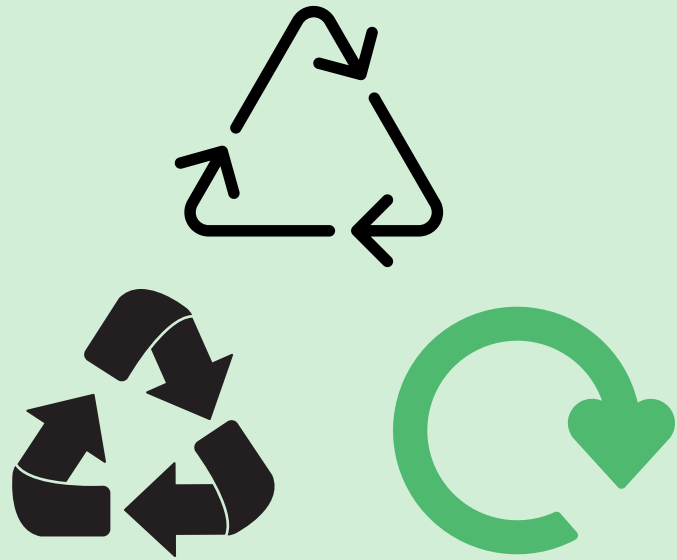
The green dot means that a financial contribution to a qualified packaging recovery organization has been made



It doesn't necessarily mean that this package can be recycled

So how do we know if an item is recyclable?

Look for these symbols



Numbers indicate the type of material so you can dispose it properly



But look closely! In plastic containers, numbers can be hard to spot, since they are small & engraved in the package



Plastic No 1, 2 & 5 are widely recycled in the UK.
