CONDITIONS FOR THE ADMISSION OF FOREIGNERS ENABLING THEM TO UNDERTAKE STUDIES IN POLISH OR ENGLISH

- 1. Foreigner may undertake education conducted in Polish language if they demonstrate sufficient Polish language profficiency, i.e.:
 - 1/complete a one-year preparatory course for undrtakin stidies in Polish in dedicated units designated by the minister responsible for higher education in Poland, or
 - 2/have a certificate of proficiency in Polish language issued by the State Commission for Certification in Polish as a Foreign Language, or
 - 3/graduated from a secondary school abroad where classes were conducted in Polish language, or
 - 4/graduated from secondary school in Poland, or
 - 5/have completed higher education in Poland in a field of study taugh in Polish, or
 - 6/Recriutment Committee will confirm during the interview that their preparation and level of Polish language proficieny allow tchem to undertake studies in Polish.
- 2. Foreigners may undertake studies conducted in English if:
 - a) they have one of the documents confirming English proficiency, listed in Annex No. 9 to this Regulation. Disclaimer: documents confirming English proficiency also include certificates, diplomas or other documents confirming completion of a secondary school abroad in which classes were conducted in the English language, as well as a diploma of completion of higher education studies in Poland conducted in English or;
 - b) Recruitment Committee will confirm during the interview that their preparation and the level of the English language proficiency allow them to undertake studies in English.
