Dr. Alexei Santiani Acosta is a Veterinarian graduated from the Universidad Nacional Mayor de San Marcos (UNMSM), Peru. He holds a PhD in Veterinary Medicine from UNMSM and a Master's degree in Reproductive Biology from the Universidad de La Frontera, Chile.

He is currently **Full Professor and Academic Vice Dean** at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, UNMSM. His teaching and research focus on **Animal Reproductive Physiology, Theriogenology, Reproductive Biotechnologies and Artificial Insemination**.

Dr. Santiani has led the Animal Reproduction Laboratory at UNMSM and served as Director of the Veterinary Medicine School and of the Department of Animal Production. His main research lines include **semen cryopreservation, sperm functional and structural evaluation, and assisted reproductive techniques** such as embryo transfer and in vitro fertilization in alpacas, sheep, cattle, horses, and dogs.

He has published numerous indexed scientific papers, directed research projects funded by national agencies such as **FONDECYT-CONCYTEC, FINCYT, and VRIP-UNMSM**, and acted as evaluator for national science and innovation programs. He has also completed training stays in **Chile, Argentina, Spain, USA, Sweden, Japan, and Turkey**, and participated in **Erasmus+ collaborations with universities in Turkey and Poland**.
